WEDNESDAY, MAY 21

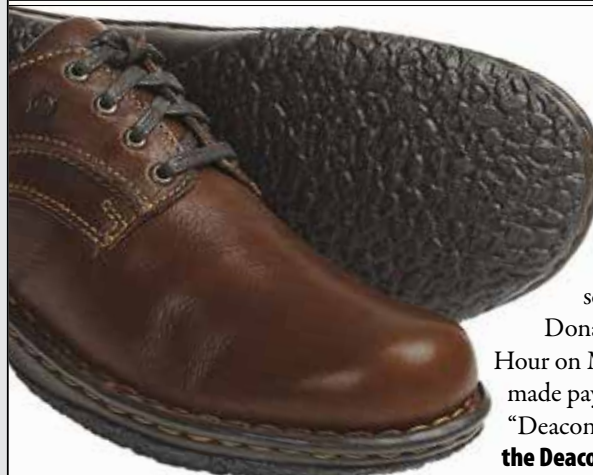
6:30 PM RECEPTION; 7 PM WORSHIP
