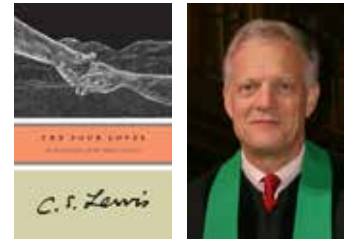
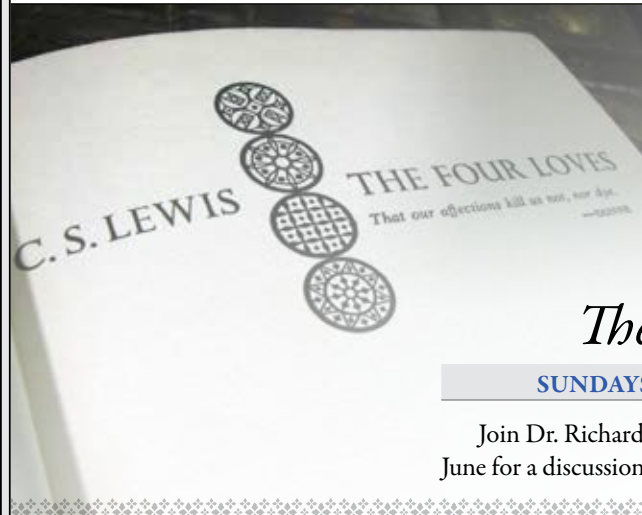
2014 Footsteps of Faith Trip
