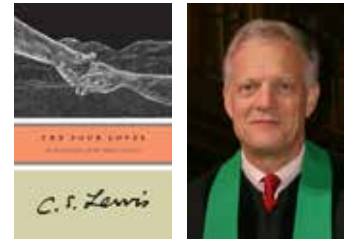
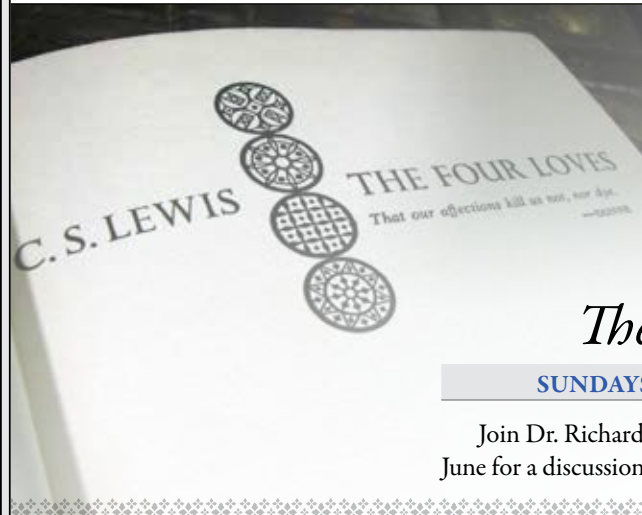
## 2014 Footsteps of Faith Trip

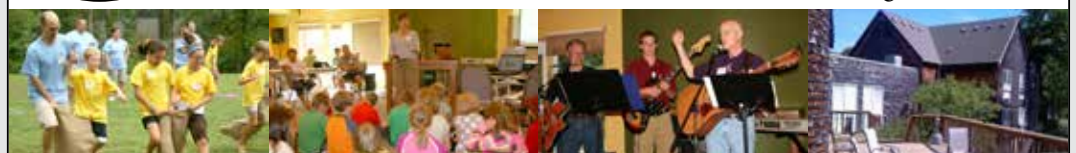

### PRELUDE & POSTLUDE NOTE

Today's prelude and postlude come from Maurice Duruflé's larger work—*Prélude, Adagio et Choral varié sur le thème du Veni Creator*, Opus 4. This 1930 composition garnered first prize in a competition organized by the Friends of the Organ, a Parisian organization. It is dedicated to one of his many teachers, Louis Vierne. A tireless perfectionist, Duruflé composed only a handful of organ works. *Veni Creator*, along with *Suite*, Op. 5, represent the only two organ works of symphonic stature by Duruflé.

### HYMN #130

*Let Every Christian Pray* was written by Fred Pratt Green in 1970 as a prayer for the Holy Spirit to come to all of God's people. Just as the Spirit breathed life into the formation of the Christian church, it continues to breathe life into the church today. Since God "never has withdrawn" the gifts that were bestowed at Pentecost, God continues to bless us with the Holy Spirit to "instruct, inspire, unite, and help us see Your light."

**HYMN #129**

**Come, O Spirit, Dwell Among Us** blends imagery drawn from the second chapter of Acts (Pentecost), and the book of Exodus (wilderness journey.) Like the Hebrew exiles, we seek God's guidance and protection in our pilgrim journey; we pray for "fire by night and cloud by day." Faithfulness to God involves more than mere acceptance of divine guidance. It requires our sharing the good news of God's redemptive love. We ask for "words of fire and flame" with which to illumine and warm the world as we share God's grace.

**COMMUNION MUSIC**

***Ave Verum Corpus***

The original Latin text for *Ave Verum Corpus* (Hail, true Body), dates from the 13th century, and was written to celebrate the feast of Corpus Christi. Over time, the *Ave Verum Corpus* text has been set to music by many of the world's greatest composers. Mozart composed a setting of it for Anton Stoll, the musical coordinator in the parish of Baden bei Wien, near Vienna. The autograph of Mozart's manuscript is dated 17 June 1791, a significant date, as this was less than six months before the composer's death. While the piece is only forty-six bars long, its masterful composition and sublime beauty are timeless.

**HYMN #128**

***On Pentecost They Gathered*** was written in 1981 by Indiana resident Jane Parker Huber. Stanzas 1 and 2 tell the narrative of Pentecost, based on Acts 2:1-11. Stanzas 3 and 4 illustrate how the Pentecost story is relevant to our lives today: God continues to "pour the Holy Spirit" on all believers, just as on the day of Pentecost. Stanza 4 is a prayer for the Spirit to bestow itself upon us and to "rekindle [our] faith."

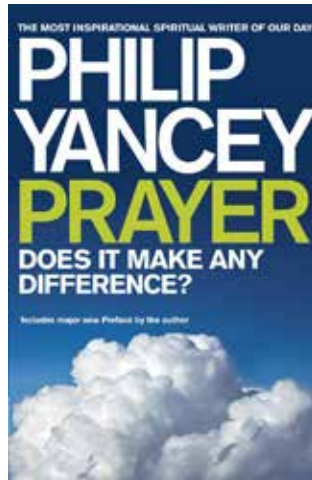

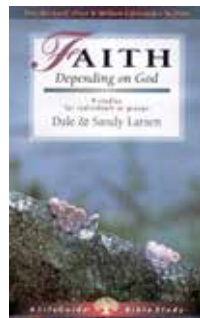
