

How Firm a Foundation is an anonymous text based on Isaiah 43:1-5: "...do not fear, for I have redeemed you; I have called you by name, you are mine. When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; And through the rivers, they shall not overwhelm you; When you walk through fire you shall not be burned, And the flame shall not consume you... Do not fear, for I am with you." The hymn dwells on this promise of divine protection and applies it to believers as they face the "deep waters" and "fiery trials" of life.

HYMN #363

I Want Jesus to Walk with Me is an affirmation, not a request, that Jesus will walk with us from our bondage into the promised land. African-American slaves identified with Jesus, who was also born on the fringe of society and who became the burden bearer of the downtrodden and oppressed. The tune was named SOJOURNER for Sojourner Truth, "the courageous freed slave woman who took to the dangerous byways of antebellum America preaching the abolition of slavery and equality for 'all o' Gawd's chillun's.'"



- f) Will you in your own life seek to follow the Lord Jesus Christ, love your neighbors, and work for the reconciliation of the world? **I will.**
- g) Do you promise to further the peace, unity, and purity of the church? **I do.**
- h) Will you seek to serve the people with energy, intelligence, imagination and love? **I will.**
- i) Will you be a faithful elder, watching over the people, providing for their worship, nurture, and service? Will you share in government and discipline, serving in governing bodies of the church, and in your ministry will you try to show the love and justice of Jesus Christ? **I will.**
